As we reflect on 2025, I am filled with gratitude and optimism for the future of Clinch Memorial Hospital. This past year has been a testament to what we can accomplish together when we unite around a shared mission: delivering exceptional healthcare close to home.

Thanks to the dedication of our staff and the unwavering support of our community, we achieved remarkable milestones. We launched our Hospitalist Program,

ensuring 24/7 physician coverage for inpatients and swing bed patients—bringing a new level of care and peace of mind to families. We expanded outpatient rehabilitation services to include adult and pediatric speech therapy, strengthening our continuum of care. Our Pulmonary Rehabilitation Program offers life-changing support for those with chronic lung conditions, and we proudly secured the Georgia Opioid Crisis Abatement Grant, enabling us to combat substance misuse through treatment, education, and Narcan distribution.

Beyond clinical advancements, we invested in our people and our environment. The creation of the Employee Renewal Room and operational improvements funded through the T.E.A.M. program reflect our commitment to staff well-being and efficiency. Community engagement remained at the heart of our mission, from hosting beloved events like Trunk or Treat and the Cowboy Ball fundraiser, to giving away over 100 school supply bags and feeding the Clinch County Panthers before their big game.

Our economic impact continues to grow—over \$22.6 million in total expenditures and 171 hospital jobs—and thanks to generous donors, we received \$626,138 through the Georgia HEART program this year alone. These contributions allow us to reinvest in technology, equipment, and services that keep healthcare strong in Clinch County.

Outpatient Rehabilitation

We've expanded our services this year!

Clinch Memorial Hospital continues to strengthen its commitment to comprehensive care by offering a full range of outpatient rehabilitation services, designed to help patients regain independence and improve quality of life. Our program now includes physical therapy, occupational therapy, and—**new in 2025**—speech therapy, providing a complete continuum of rehabilitative care close to home.

Physical Therapy focuses on restoring mobility, reducing pain, and improving strength and balance for patients recovering from injuries, surgeries, or chronic conditions.

Occupational Therapy helps individuals adapt to daily activities, ensuring they can safely and confidently manage tasks at home and work.

Adult and Pediatric Speech Therapy, introduced in May 2025, addresses communication and swallowing disorders for patients of all ages, including those recovering from strokes or managing developmental challenges.

With a team of highly skilled therapists and personalized treatment plans, our outpatient rehab services empower patients to achieve their goals in a supportive environment. Start your therapy journey with us by calling (912) 470-2532.

Swing Bed Services (912) 470-2522

Swing Bed helps patients transition from hospital to home with Physical Therapy and other skilled nursing services in a caring and comfortable environment. These services may be an appropriate option for after orthopedic surgery, trauma-related injury, stroke or brain injury, infection or disease requiring IV antibiotics, difficult wound healing, cardiac conditioning, and more. Our team meets regularly with the patient and their family to review progress and work towards the best outcome for the patient.

Laboratory Services (912) 470-2542

Bacteriology, Clinical Chemistry and Immunology, Hematology, Immunochemistry, Mycology I, Parasitology, Therapeutic Drug Testing, Transfusion Services, Toxicology, Urinalysis

Radiology Services (912) 470-2594

The Radiology Department provides Quality Medical Imaging services in a professional and timely manner. Services provided include Diagnostic Radiographic Exams (X-Rays), Computed Tomography (CT), Mammography and Ultrasonography.

Emergency Services (912) 470-2521

The Emergency Room is for those with serious problems of an urgent nature. The Emergency Room is staffed by full-time providers who provide 24-hour care, seven days a week.

Respiratory Services (912) 470-2536

Therapies: oxygen, aerosol and nebulizer, Incentive Spirometry, Chest Physiotherapy, Airway Suctioning. Testing: Pulmonary Function Testing, Methacholine Challenge Testing, Holter Monitor, Arterial Blood Gas Analysis, Sleep Study

In addition to early detection of colorectal cancer and polyps, our GI experts provide testings, such as colonoscopy, evaluation, and treatment of many common digestive disorders including, but not limited to: Irritable Bowel Syndrome (IBS), Barrett's esophagus, Constipation, Hepatitis, Crohn's disease, Gallstones, and more.

Hospitalist Program Enhances Patient Care at Clinch Memorial Hospital

In January 2025, Clinch Memorial Hospital proudly launched its Hospitalist Program, marking a significant milestone in our commitment to providing exceptional inpatient care. Through a partnership with SMH Innovations, we now offer 24/7 physician coverage for both inpatients and swing bed patients—a service that ensures continuous, high-quality medical oversight.

This program brings a dedicated team of hospitalists to CMH, delivering expert care around the clock. At the heart of this initiative is Dr. Jerome Tuitt, who serves as the primary physician liaison. Dr. Tuitt and his colleagues work

closely with our nursing staff and therapists to coordinate treatment plans, manage acute conditions, and provide personalized care tailored to each patient's needs. The physicians are on a seven-day rotation every few weeks.

The introduction of hospitalists has already demonstrated measurable benefits, including improved patient outcomes, enhanced communication among care teams, and greater peace of mind for families knowing their loved ones have immediate access to a physician at any hour.

By embracing this innovative model, Clinch Memorial Hospital continues to advance rural healthcare, ensuring our community receives the same level of comprehensive care found in larger facilities, **right here at home!**

CLINCH MEMORIAL PHARMACY

The Clinch Memorial Pharmacy is located inside of the hospital's facility and serves Clinch County and surrounding communities. Anyone can fulfill their prescriptions at Clinch Memorial Pharmacy, regardless of if they are a patient at Clinch Memorial Hospital or not.

BENEFITS

The pharmacy qualifies for the 340B Drug Pricing Program. This program requires drug manufacturers to sell outpatient drugs at a discount to safety-net providers, such as CMH. For example, the same 10 ml vial of insulin that normally sells for about \$350 costs just \$2 to \$25 through the 340b program at Clinch Memorial for qualifying patients. Clinch Memorial Pharmacy also provides Meds-to-Beds services, a free service that offers education about medication and delivers prescriptions to patients. Inpatients and Emergency Room patients have the convenience of receiving their prescriptions before they leave the hospital.

HomeTown Health has conducted "Policymaker Tours" since 2010 with a focus on bringing legislators and others from the Atlanta Capitol building onsite in rural hospitals to see the facilities, learn about their challenges, learn about their successes, and get a real-life view of the rural communities served by rural hospitals throughout Georgia. Clinch Memorial Receives Georgia Opioid Crisis Abatement Grant

Clinch Memorial Hospital is proud to announce that it has been awarded the Georgia Opioid Crisis Abatement Grant, a significant milestone in our ongoing commitment to improving community health and combating substance misuse. This grant represents a crucial investment in rural healthcare and underscores our dedication to addressing one of the most pressing public health challenges of our time.

The opioid epidemic has deeply impacted communities across Georgia, and Clinch County is no exception. With this funding, Clinch Memorial Hospital will implement comprehensive strategies aimed at prevention, treatment, and recovery support. Key initiatives include:

- **Expanded Access to Treatment:** Enhancing medication-assisted treatment (MAT) programs and counseling services for individuals struggling with opioid use disorder.
- **Community Education and Outreach:** Launching awareness campaigns to inform residents about opioid risks, safe medication practices, and available resources.
- **Naloxone Distribution and Training:** Providing life-saving Narcan kits and training to first responders, families, and community members.


